THE CRUS CREW: NORTH TO SOUTH BY BOTTLE

Beaujolais is a Gamay wonderland. The Crus are the ten named villages that have long been recognized for their own unique personalities, height & mineral composition play major roles within a complex tapestry of terroirs.

“Great Beaujolais inherently invokes the beautiful in life, but that doesn’t mean it can’t be taken seriously.” – Rajat Parr

SAINT-AMOUR – complex soils, most northerly Cru, nervy, red-fruited, rarer...

2022 Michel & Sylvain Tête / Domaine du Clos du Fief *Les Capitans* high density, crushed granite slopes, planted 1976 110

JULIÉNAS – more structured, sturdier, built around their fruit: cherries, cassis, spice...

2022 Michel & Sylvain Tête / Domaine du Clos du Fief semi-carbonic in cement, indigenous yeast, juicy core 95

2022 La Soeur Cadette organically farmed, granite soil, whole cluster 110

2023 Domaine de la Cure *Le Jules* labelled Vin de France but fruit from Juliéнас, biodynamic, no sulfur, natural 125

CHÉNAS – smallest, often overlooked, steep slopes, a rarity to embrace, generally fuller...

2020 Famille Dutraive *lieu dit ‘en Papolet’* family project in response to 90% of crop losses in Fleurie due to hailstorms in 2016 125

2023 Domaine de la Cure *Crapule* doesn’t say so but it’s from Chénas, young vines, subtle cocoa & meat locker on nose 125

2012 Jules Desjournays *Le Jugement Dernier* earth, raspberry, potpourri 175

MOULIN-À-VENT – most powerful, lots of granite, long-lived with tannic intensity...

2021 Jean-Paul Dubost *En Brenay* 60 year old vines, full carbonic, spice, warmth 125

2017 Château des Jacques *Clos de Rochegrès* mocha, candied flowers, oak spice, blood orange 135

2021 Domaine Saint-Cyr *La Bruyère* whole-bunch, 21 days carbonic, 10 months aging vats & old casks, un-fined & filtered 145

2010 Jules Desjournays *Les Michelons* dark berry, plum, smoke, big raps when released 195

FLEURIE – generous & fragrant, think florals, violets, famous & popular Cru...

2019 Jean Foillard violet, wet earth, red & blue, five-spice 135

CHIROUBLES – highest Cru, steep slopes, bright, cool & fresh, a Cru to watch...

2020 Domaine Lafarge Vial 30% whole cluster, pepper, cranberry, game 135

2021 Domaine Lafarge Vial cooler year, kirsch, minerals 135

MORGON – geologically diverse, granite plus, second largest Cru, cherished site of Côte du Py, overflowing with top wines & producers, deep colours, serious fruit depth...

BROUILLY – largest & southernmost Cru, diversity of soils, vibrant, fruit-driven, florals...

2021 Alexandre Burgaud it all starts here (with Joseph Drouhin) 75

2022 Jean-Paul Dubost *Vieilles Vignes* 80 year old vines from 3 villages in northern Brouilly, semi-carbonic 105

2022 Pierre-Marie Chermette *Pierreux* often more brooding, this year finer, aromatic with wild blue fruit 110

2021 Alex Foillard “generous dash of plump, sun-ripened fruit enveloping its granite core” - *Kermit Lynch* 115

2022 Jean-Claude Lapalu *Vieilles Vignes* acclaimed, natural-swinging, gifted with old vines 120

2020 Bret Brothers *Cuvée Zen* we love their whites, this is rarer; completely de-stemmed, no added sulfur 165

CÔTE DE BROUILLY – high ground, volcanic hill, structured, tends towards riper end...

2021 Château Thivin *Les Sept Vignes* blended from 7 plots, a beacon for the appellation 110

2021 Alex Foillard whole bunch fermented for 3-4 weeks, 50% aged in old oak 115

“THE EMPEROR’S NEW” (‘THEY THOUGHT IT WAS GAMAY’) SECTION

2021 Rippon “Gamay”, Lake Wanaka, Central Otago, NZ	135
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Big news out of Central Otago very recently & Lake Wanaka's Rippon in particular is that their famed gamay has been identified as being in fact...wait for it...pinot noir. In June of this year, Rippon's Nick Mills requested a DNA analysis of the property's ungrafted “gamay” vines (planted in 1987, tiny plot: 11 rows, 0.338ha) & it has now been confirmed they are as-yet-unidentified clones of pinot noir that have managed to not reveal their true identity for nearly 40 years. Who else has used the so-called “Rippon” clone of gamay? Rippon's unique, ageworthy, structured, “gamay” all makes sense now...great wine just not gamay unfortunately (don't get me started on albariño & savagnin in Australia)

GOOD YEAR? – OUR QUICK BOJO VINTAGE GUIDE

2023 – Jury still out...

Drought year (like 2022) isolated severe summer hail & storms, perfumed, fresh-fruited, our first '23's arriving...

2022 – Excellent

Warm, dry year, some erratic weather, low production but rich wines

2021 – Good to Excellent

Start of growing season difficult but Aug/Sept warm & dry, fresh wines to be drunk sooner

2020 – Exceptional

June a bit cold & wet but otherwise quite hot, second earliest harvest on record. Outstanding

2019 – Excellent to Exceptional

Quantity down, quality up, severe frosts reduced group, concentrated wines

2015 – Exceptional

Hot summer offset by rains & cool nights, early harvest, dark, fruity, chewy wines

2014 – Excellent

Cool summer but harvest hot & dry, more 'classic' wines than 2015

2012 – Good to Excellent

Smallest harvest in 40 years produced vibrant, concentrated wines

2010 – Excellent

Small crop, small berries, acidity up, Crus needed time
